### **Report of the Quartermaster**

**Report of the Service Officer**. Art Hauessler reports there is a major focus on women veterans. Reports show that women Veterans comprise of 15% of our active duty military and 18% of guardian reserves. The VA has been confusing female veterans as spouses and dependents instead of looking at them as individuals. The focus is not to identify an outreach program. They will look at all the homeless figures as well as a separate united for all homeless. Next President Biden signed the National Defense Act. It's the largest pay increase in 22 years. It is 5.2% and the total defense package was \$886 Billion. Next is Camp Lejune. Art shared we have been talking about it on and of through the past year. . The VFW has partnered with two law firms to address the issue. The criteria is to have a minimum of 30 days at Camp Lejune, whether working there, stationed there, or on and off the base for 30 days. Now there is a fund that you can go through with the Camp Lejeune involving a lawsuit. He shared that there is a request to remembers the VFW Nation Home program that has been in place since 1925. Its to help the families and Veterans during difficult medical times. He reported he had seven new claims, one was a female batter claim. Her service was 1981 to 1985 and never knew she had that. Our focus should be to try and see who else is out there that we can help withing the community. Secondly Art shared a program called Grants for Arts Projects: Briefly Support from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) supposes a program that they share "The National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) supports the nations art sector with grant opportunities so that together we can help everyone live more artful lives." The program will be available for us in the City of Vista. (copies of the program highlights will be provided at the February meeting.
